**SUBJECT:** 2025 HOME Homeownership Development Program Funding Recommendation

Attached is the funding award matrix under the 2025 HOME Homeownership Development Program. THDA set aside 20% of its total 2025 HOME allocation of \$13.3M for this purpose, making over \$2.6 million available for Program awards and \$184,455 for Operating Assistance. We received four applications, requesting \$3,137,849 in total funds.

Staff recommend the award of two applications, in the amount of \$1,510,000 in Program funds and \$105,700 in Operating Assistance that will fund development of eight homes for sale to low-income homebuyers, with five in the West Grand Division and three in the East Grand Division.

Staff do not recommend awards to the following applicants due to not meeting threshold requirements:

- Assurance Development and Management Corporation The nonprofit did not provide a formal, written process for low-income beneficiaries to advise in the nonprofit's decisions regarding the design, site selection, development, and management of affordable housing. The process must be described in the organization's by-laws or have been adopted by its board by resolution.
- <u>The Housing Hub</u> The nonprofit did not demonstrate two years of experience serving the community in housing related activities.
